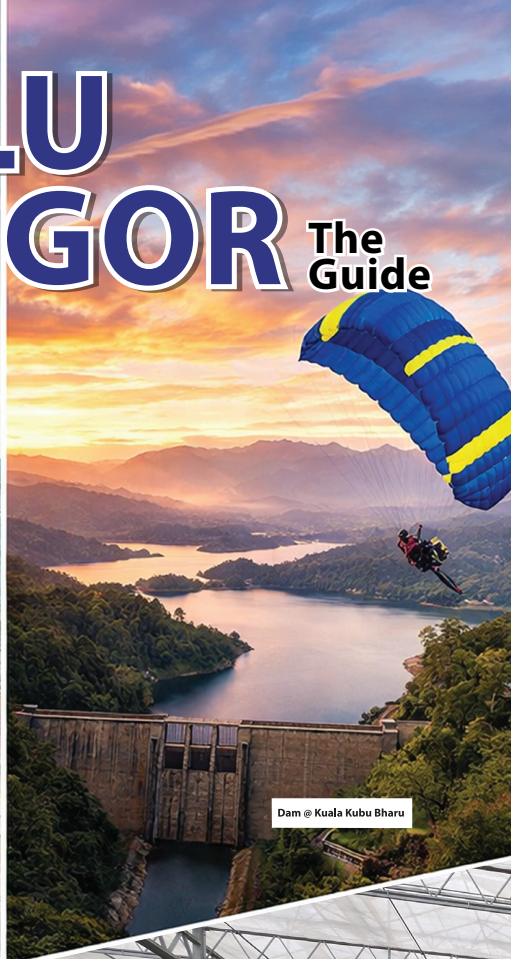

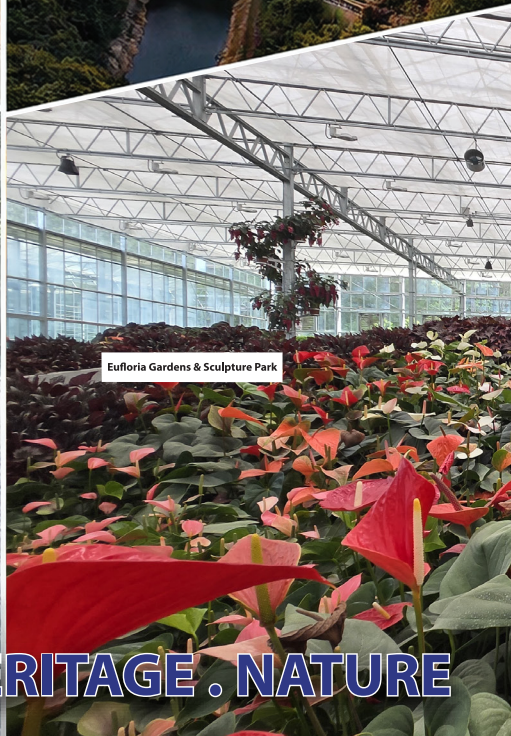

# Welcome to Hulu Selangor

Hulu Selangor is a district renowned for its lush greenery, charming highland retreats, and rich cultural heritage. From tranquil hot springs and scenic waterfalls to historical towns and indigenous communities, the district offers a refreshing escape for nature lovers, culture seekers, and adventure enthusiasts alike. Whether you're exploring the cool mountain air of Fraser's Hill or experiencing traditional village life, Hulu Selangor promises a unique and enriching journey.

## PROFILE

Hulu Selangor is one of the nine administrative districts in the state of Selangor, Malaysia. Covering over 1,700 square kilometres, it is characterised by its verdant hills, rivers, and forest reserves. Key towns include Kuala Kubu Bharu, Batang Kali, and Serendah. With a population comprising various ethnic groups, the district blends modern living with traditional charm, supported by agriculture, eco-tourism, and local industries.

## CLIMATE

Hulu Selangor experiences a tropical rainforest climate, with warm temperatures averaging between 23°C to 32°C throughout the year. Rainfall is frequent, especially during the monsoon seasons from April to May and October to December. The highland areas such as Fraser's Hill enjoy cooler temperatures, making them a popular retreat from the heat of the lowlands.

## CURRENCY

The official currency used in Hulu Selangor, as in the rest of Malaysia, is the Malaysian Ringgit (MYR), denoted as RM. Most towns and tourist areas accept major credit and debit cards, though it is advisable to carry cash when visiting rural areas, local markets, or remote attractions.

## COMMON COURTESIES

Visitors to Hulu Selangor are encouraged to respect local customs and dress modestly, especially when visiting rural communities, places of worship, or indigenous settlements. A simple greeting of "Selamat Sejahtera" goes a long way in establishing friendly rapport. Removing shoes before entering homes or mosques is customary. Respect for elders, use of the right hand when giving or receiving items, and refraining from public displays of affection are also appreciated cultural practices.

## RELIGION

Hulu Selangor is home to a diverse religious landscape. Islam is the official religion and practised by the majority Malay community, while Buddhism, Hinduism, and Christianity are also observed by other ethnic groups. Notably, the district is home to the indigenous Temuan people, one of the sub-groups of the Orang Asli (original peoples) of Peninsular Malaysia. The Temuan maintain spiritual beliefs deeply connected to nature and ancestral traditions, and some continue to practise animism alongside modern faiths.

## LANGUAGE

Daerah Hulu Selangor (dahulu dieja Ulu Selangor) merupakan salah sebuah daerah yang terletak di utara Negeri Selangor. Dari sudut geografi, Daerah Hulu Selangor terletak di utara Lembah Klang dengan keluasan 175,630.11 hektar, hampir sama keluasan dengan Negeri Melaka.

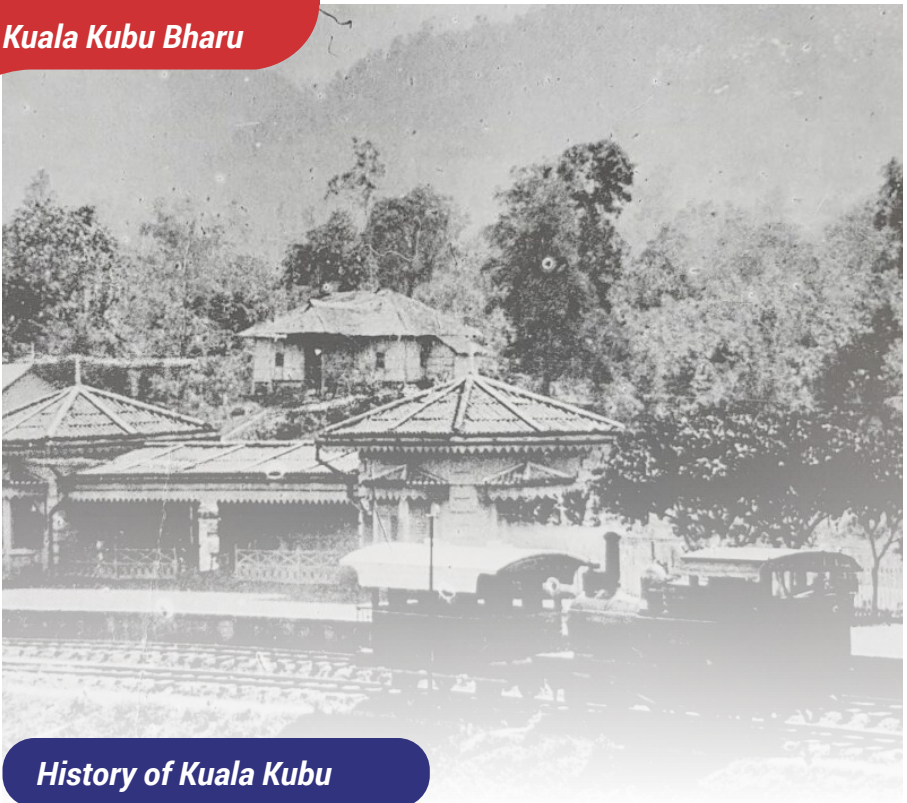

### History of Kuala Kubu

The town of Kuala Kubu Bharu (KKB), also known as Kuala Kubu was an active tin mining area when it was established in the 1870s. The Kuala Kubu name derives from the kinship where Raja Mahadi and his followers used Kuala Kubu as a fortress. However, after the British commissioner's arrival in the 1870s, Kuala Kubu became Ulu Selangor's administrative base, which also acted as a tax collection centre for mining activities. Jalan Persekutuan 55 was constructed about the same year, linking Selangor and Fraser's Hill, Pahang.

After the catastrophic floods due to the dam breaking and drowning part of the Kuala Kubu area, the British relocated the administrative centre temporarily to Rasa town. In the 1920s, a town planner from New Zealand, named Charles Crompton Reade planned the initial development of Kuala Kubu Bharu which was located 3.2 km north of the original site of Kuala Kubu by highlighting the idea of Garden City.

When the old town of Kuala Kubu was completely destroyed during a flood in 1883, the town of Kuala Kubu Bharu (KKB) was founded (bharu meaning 'new' in Malay). The town of KKB is situated at the foot of the popular Titiwangsa Mountain Range and is well known as one of the Selangor State's important water catchment area. Kuala Kubu Bharu is possibly Asia's first garden township, designed in 1925 by the first British Federated Malay States (FMS) government town planner, Charles Crompton Reade. The old shops built in the 1920s adds to the antique feel of the town.



# Garden City Heritage Trail

## **KUALA KUBU BHARU**

The Selangor state government is working towards getting Kuala Kubu Bharu town listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, under the Garden City Heritage category. The UNESCO branding is important to further attract foreign and domestic tourists to Kuala Kubu Bharu as well as the state of Selangor.

As a tourist destination, Kuala Kubu Bharu is rich in eco-tourism activities such as hiking at Bukit Kutu and Lata Medang, trekking to Chiling waterfall, paragliding, white water rafting and mountain biking.

Annual sporting events held at Kuala Kubu Bharu includes Kuala Kubu Bharu paragliding Accuracy Championship, Selangor International Bird Race and Pertak Trail Run.



## *Kuala Kubu Bharu*



### *District Office*

This administrative complex houses the District Office and the Magistrate's Court. The British learned a lesson from the great flood that hit Kuala Kubu Lama by building an administrative building on a hill for security purposes. The complex was completed on November 3rd 1930.



### *King George VI Memorial Clock Tower*



The King George VI Memorial Clock Tower is a landmark in Kuala Kubu Bharu District. It is located at the top of Bukit Kerajaan and in front of the Hulu Selangor Land/District Office, Kuala Kubu Bharu Town can be seen. It was designed in 1937 to celebrate the coronation of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth, King and Queen of England.

### *Hulu Selangor Traffic Police Headquarters*

Situated at the top of Bukit Kerajaan, the Hulu Selangor Police Headquarters was built in 1914, and the primary use of the building was a church called The Church of Ascension for Angelic believers. The structure has traditional features of Victorian buildings, such as a small rooftop dome. This building was renovated by C.C. Reade (1880-1933) when the Bukit Kerajaan area was planned as the Kuala Kubu Bharu Administrative Centre in 1926.



## **Kuala Kubu Bharu Post Office**

The Kuala Kubu Bharu Post Office building was constructed around the 1930s, along with the creation of the Kuala Kubu Bharu area. Designed in a neo-classical architectural style, the main features of the building are round gable windows and round casement windows. The post office has been serving the area for over 80 years, and many improvements and renovations have been made from time to time, but the base structure is still in place and the windows that make the building look different are very well preserved.



## **Rumah Kedai No. 1 & No. 2, Jalan Dato Tabal**

Shophouses No.1 (PWD 211) & No. 2 (PWD 212) are historic buildings which were confiscated by the security forces during the Malayan Emergency.



## **Surau Lama**

The building with the design "Sino-Malay Palladian" is a surau for the Kuala Kubu Bharu City area which is now used as an Islamic Nursery.



## **Masjid Warisan Al Hidayah**

The Masjid Warisan Al Hidayah is located 2 kilometres from the heart of KKB Town. It is said that the mosque was hit by multiple flash floods which were caused by waters overflowing from the tin mine, but the main structure of the mosque remained intact.





### *St Paul's Catholic Church, Kuala Kubu Bharu*

Part of the Church was also once used as a kindergarten. The iconic arched gable as the front façade is certainly a piece of impressive art. The stone wall is evidently influenced by British architecture in the past, either pre- or post-colonial period. Fraser Hills was a 45-minute-drive quick escape for British colonial officers who were once stationed here. The tall casement windows and concrete vents above also reflect the age of the design. This church was built in 1957 by H.E MSGR D Vendargon

### *Gurdwara Sahib Kuala Kubu Bharu*

The Gurdwara was first built by the Sikhs who resided in Kuala Kubu. The initial structure was built in Ampang Pechah, Kuala Kubu (Kuala Kubu Lama) and was destroyed in the great flood that happened in 1926. Later the government allocated half-acre land when the new town of KKB was formed. The new Gurdwara was opened to the public in 1931.



### *Kuan Yik Kerk Temple*

The iconic "Guan Yin" Temple is located on a small hill at the top of KKB City. You can see a fleet of colourful rainbow stairs that have been restored by the locals to decorate the temple and the ancient crafts draw attention to every detail that has been created.



### Old Fire Station

The Old Fire Station building was constructed in 1931. Designed in a neo-classical theme, the fire station has three lanes of fire engines, toilets, kitchens and shops. This fire station is registered under P.W.D No.112. The fire station is currently being used as Hulu Selangor Tourism Information Centre.



### Coates Theatre (1953)

The Art Deco style cinema was completed in 1953. The theatre was called Coates Theater in accordance with the name of Hulu Selangor District Officer P.A. Coates, who served in 1950-1952.



### Kedai Makanan Hailam Sun Sun Nam Cheong

This 100-year-old food shop is run by Mr Tan, a Chinese descendant of Hainan. Among the common items in this shop are coffee toast and chicken chop. Apart from that, this shop also displays a collection of old images of Kuala Kubu Bharu.



### Mahogany Tree

This place marks the area that was used to plant mahogany trees in Kuala Kubu Bharu which then became the main tree found in the Kuala Kubu Bharu area. This is also the official tree for MPHS.



# Chiling Waterfall & **Ikan Kelah Sanctuary** (Malaysian Mahseer)

The scenic Sungai Chiling is located within the Sungai Chiling Fish Sanctuary, a protected conservation and fisheries research area managed by the Department of Fisheries, Selangor. Renowned for its pristine rainforest environment and crystal-clear waters, Chiling Waterfall is widely regarded as one of Selangor's most impressive natural attractions.

Visitors are required to embark on an adventurous jungle trek of approximately one hour to reach the waterfall, which involves crossing the Chiling River several times. The journey offers a rewarding experience for nature lovers and adventure seekers alike.

Prior to entering the sanctuary, all visitors are required to obtain a forest entry permit. The permit system is implemented to ensure visitor safety, regulate daily visitor numbers and protect the fragile forest ecosystem. Permits must be obtained in advance from the designated authority before commencing the trek.

Upon arrival, visitors will be rewarded with a series of cascading waterfalls, commonly referred to as three-tier waterfalls, surrounded by lush tropical rainforest. The sanctuary is also home to the protected ikan kelah, a freshwater species that thrives in clean and well-preserved river habitats.

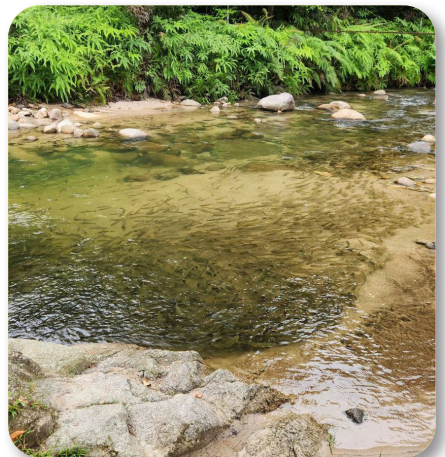




The entrance to Sungai Chiling is located along the route towards The Gap / Fraser's Hill from Kuala Kubu Bharu. After passing the Selangor Dam and reservoir, visitors will cross a small steel bridge over the Chiling River. A designated parking area is located shortly after the bridge, with the entrance to the sanctuary situated on the right-hand side of the road. Sungai Chiling is also locally known as Gorilla Falls.

# HIKING

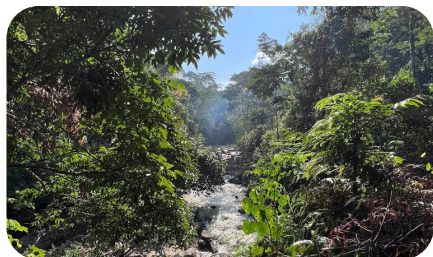
## *Bukit Kutu*

Bukit Kutu is an attractive location for hiking enthusiasts, trail runners and those who are new to hiking. There are several junctions in the forest leading to the top that can take you far from the city. It is close to Kuala Lumpur so it is easy for travellers to get there, but you should go up with someone who knows the ins and outs. Bukit Kutu is a 10.0 kilometre moderately trekked trail which features a waterfall and is considered difficult. The trail is mostly used for hiking.



## *Lata Medang*

Lata Medang is a 10.0 km out and back trail that offers scenic views and is rated as difficult. The route is mostly used for hiking, cycling, camping, and backpacking activities. In a remote area of hilly rainforest off Kuala Kubu Bharu, Lata Medang is a waterfall at Kampung Pertak, cascading down from a massive 60-meter drop over two stages. Access is through the initial trail to Bukit Kutu.



## *Lata Jebus*

Situated near the historic town of Kuala Kubu Bharu, Lata Jebus is a charming natural attraction that blends scenic beauty with cultural significance. This multi-tiered waterfall flows gently over rocky terrain, creating inviting pools ideal for a refreshing dip. Popular among both locals and weekend explorers, Lata Jebus is easily accessible and offers a relaxing escape amidst the forested landscape. The site is also a great stop for those exploring the heritage trails of Kuala Kubu Bharu, combining outdoor leisure with the district's rich historical offerings.



# Kuala Kubu Bharu Hot Springs

Situated near Taman Arif, the Kuala Kubu Bharu Hot Spring is a quiet retreat that has remained one of Hulu Selangor's lesser-known natural treasures. Discovered just over a decade ago, this geothermal spring was initially kept under the radar by local residents who preferred to enjoy its therapeutic warmth in solitude.

Today, while still retaining its calm and rustic charm, the site has seen minor upgrades, including the addition of two gazebos by the district council to provide shade and comfort for visitors. Surrounded by nature, the hot springs offer a relaxing spot for those seeking to unwind and rejuvenate, particularly after exploring nearby eco-attractions. Though modest in size, its natural setting and local character make it a meaningful stop on any wellness or nature-themed itinerary.



# Street Art

## Kuala Kubu Bharu

### *Orang Asli Temuan Streets*

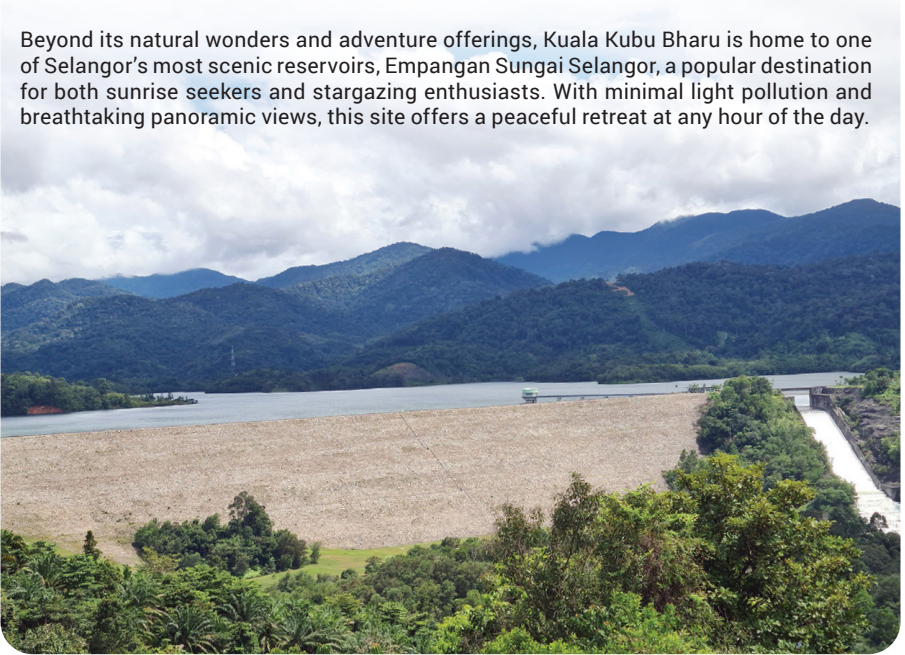

# Lookout Point & Stargazing Spot at Empangan Sungai Selangor

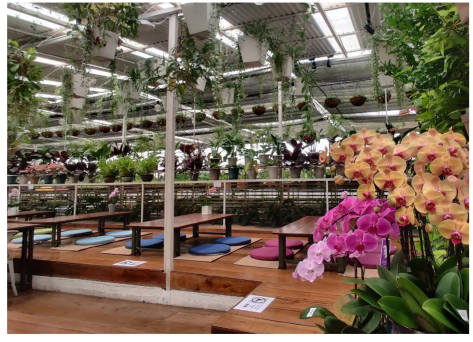
