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# About Kuala Langat

## *History*

In terms of the name, Kuala Langat is believed to have been contrived from its position at the estuary of Sungai Langat. In fact, it directly translates to "Confluence of the Langat River". However, there have been similar folk narratives that have led to not only the formulation of the name but the reinforcement of it too. Correlating to the term 'air hangat' (translates to lukewarm water) in the Minangkabau dialect, it was said that traders who utilised this river as their trade route discovered that the water at the mouth of the river was consistently warm. On top of that, the selangat fish residing here may have further cemented the 'Langat' name.

Also referred to as 'Langat' by the locals, the initial location of Kuala Langat town was in Jugra (formerly known as Bandar Temasya). Similar to other areas in Selangor, it appears to have been founded by the Bugis community that arrived from Johor during the 18th century trade with Melaka. Although the history of the region most likely goes much further back, evidence suggests that Kuala Langat had already existed around 2,000 to 2,500 years ago. This occurred even before the expansion of the Malacca Sultanate.

In recent years, Kuala Langat has greatly transformed from the sleepy district, consisting of small towns and villages, it was once known for. Since the 21st century, the district has blossomed into the bustling and dynamic township it is today. Aside from modern infrastructure, there is a fastly growing manufacturing and commercial hub at the center of it all.



## Population And Area

Located in the southwestern region of Selangor, Kuala Langat spans across an estimated area of 85,770 square kilometres. Within it, the district is separated into eight sub-districts or administrative divisions which consist of Jugra, Telok Panglima Garang, Bandar, Tanjung Dua Belas I, Tanjung Dua Belas II, Kelanang, Morib and Batu; these areas have been listed from North to South, accordingly. Moreover, the Langat River also runs along several towns in Kuala Langat: Banting, Telok Datok, Jenjarom, Jugra and Carey Island.

Regarding the neighbouring districts, it is mainly nestled between Klang in the North-West and Sepang in the South-East. Additionally, it has a small border connection to the Petaling Jaya district. Furthermore, the Straits of Malacca is directly located in the West. Therefore, this territory contains a long sandy stretch of coastline. Other attractive terrains include wetlands, palm oil plantations, rivers, forest reserves, hills and beaches. Overall, it's no surprise that Kuala Langat has flourished as an agricultural district, with the primary crop comprising oil palm.

In terms of the population, this district has approximately 357,420 total residents. Diving into ethnicity, Kuala Langat is home to the Malay, Chinese, Indian, Javanese and Orang Asli communities. In fact, there are two main groups of indigenous people: Mah Meri and Temuan. However, it is fair to say that the Malays amount to the overwhelming majority.

# Getting Around Kuala Langat

## Car

From Kuala Lumpur City: Via South Klang Valley Expressway/ E26 and Route 5  
: Via Federal Highway and Route 2

From Shah Alam City: Via Kemuning - Shah Alam Expressway / E13 and Route 5  
: Via ELITE/AH2/E6 and Route 5

All four routes for both cities will later link to Jalan Klang Banting / Route 5 before turning into Jalan Sultan Alam Shah / Route 5. Without factoring traffic, the overall journey for:

Kuala Lumpur: about 1 hour to 1 ½ hour maximum  
Shah Alam: about 50 minutes to 1 hour maximum

## Public Transport

Using a combination of trains, buses and taxi:

From Kuala Lumpur Central, take the Kelana Jaya Line (LRT) to Pasar Seni. From KL 1596 Hub Pasar Seni - G, take BET 11 towards LG 29 Terminal Banting, Jalan Sultan Abdul Samad. Once arrived, take a taxi to your destination. The total journey will amount to approximately 2 hours.

## Historical Sites

### *Jugra Insitu Museum*

Possessing a history as the first prison in Selangor is the Jugra Insitu Museum. Using rectangular granite stones, it was built by British police officer Captain Harry Charles Syers in 1878. The ground floor stood as the police station-cum-jailhouse while the top floor held the courtroom; operations ceased when Pudu Prison was constructed in 1890. The structure also functioned as the administrative centre of the Selangor Sultanate, before it relocated to Klang.

Currently, it serves as a museum with three galleries showcasing information, artefacts and dioramas of the history (including heritage sites) and development of Kuala Langat as well as the archaeological and conservation works of Rumah Pasung. One of the main attractions consist of the WWII armoured personnel carriers ridden by the Royal Malaysian Police during the Emergency Period (1948-1960).

### *Istana Bandar*

Constructed in 1899, the magnificent Istana Bandar was commissioned by Sultan Ala'eddin Sulaiman Shah Ibni Al-Marhum Raja Muda Musa (fifth Sultan of Selangor) after the death of his nephew, Sultan Abdul Samad ibni Almarhum Raja Abdullah, the year before. Also referred to as Istana Alae'ddin, the building was his home until his death in 1938. It then became the Selangor government's administrative center before the Independence era; later turned into a craft and religion center.

Made of brick and lime mortar with chengal wood, the double-storey palace stretches across 5 hectares with 44 rooms along with a verandah and a forbidden garden. The architecture is a blend of Asian and colonial influences. For example, Islamic designs originating from India and the Middle-Eastern region are the primary features while Chinese elements can be seen in the dragon scale wall carvings.

## Hatter's Castle

Inspired by Scottish author A.J. Cronin's novel of the same name, Hatter's Castle is actually a four-storey cottage bungalow built during the early 1920s British colonisation period. Covering about 496 square metres, the design of this home is believed to be influenced by the founder of Carey Island, Edward Valentine John Carey. A tranquil atmosphere filled with lush greenery surrounds the site. Its first occupants comprised the first general manager of the Jugra Land & Carey Limited plantation company and the Danish engineer who aided in the building's construction. It is presently maintained by Golden Hope Plantation as the farm owner, and used mainly as a staff and company guest house for Sime Darby Plantation these days.

## Tugu Badminton Anak-Anak Sidek

Badminton fans and sports history enthusiasts should stop by Tugu Badminton Anak-Anak Sidek. If you're unfamiliar with the Sidek name, the five sons of Haji Sidek – Misbun, Razif, Jalani, Rahman and Rashid – are Malaysian badminton masters who won titles and medals at many international competitions, including the Olympics, Thomas Cup and World Grand Prix. Apart from a monument of a shuttlecock and two intersecting badminton rackets, there is a large mural depicting the siblings here. Additionally, the family home and its compound that once served as the practice area for the boys is still standing.

## Kompleks Makam Almarhum Sultan Abdul Samad

Kompleks Makam Almarhum Sultan Abdul Samad is a royal mausoleum housing the fourth Sultan of Selangor who ruled from 1857 to 1898. This building is easily recognisable by the pastel yellow tone; the base colour associated with Malay sultans. Regarding the design, Moorish and Islamic elements are incorporated. While his tomb is situated inside the mausoleum, the tombs of his wife and relatives are kept outside. Fittingly, there are blooming yellow cempaka trees growing in the surrounding area. Moreover, its position on a hilltop invites a beautiful panoramic view of the area.

# Heritage And Cultural Tourism

## Mah Meri Cultural Village

Living predominantly on Carey Island, the ancient Mah Meri tribe is a sub-group of the Senoi community who live along the coast of Selangor. They constitute one of the 18 remaining indigenous communities thriving in Peninsular Malaysia. In total, six of their settlements exist on the island, namely Kampung Sungai Judah, Kampung Sungai Bumbun, Kampung Sungai Rambai, Kampung Kepau Laut, Kampung Sungai Jugra and Kampung Sungai Kurau. The Mah Meri people tend to live in isolation away from the large Malay population, partially due to the island's separation from the mainland (thanks to the Langat River). In spite of this, they are considered generally fluent in the national language.

In terms of beliefs, they still retain the animism practice. Similarly, they place great faith and respect in the spirits of their ancestors who are thought to assist in their daily lives – especially grandparents and famous tribespeople. In fact, one of the largest celebrations is Hari Moyang (Ancestor's Day) with prayer rituals as an important activity. It usually takes place around March or April. However, this festivity differs from settlement to settlement. While the agricultural Kampung Sungai Bumbun celebrates in February on land, the fishing-centered Kampung Sungai Judah does so in September on the beach as these locations are part of their income source. Additionally, wedding ceremonies are a huge affair here. Although the cultural village is open all year round, it is recommended to visit during these grand events. Other than that, do check out the unique art shows involving mythologies and local legends.

The Mah Meri are known to be extremely skilled mask makers. These intricately carved full face masks are then worn by the tribespeople to perform the traditional Jo'oh dance and mask dance during festivals. Statue carving is also a perfected skill here, particularly in Kampung Sungai Bumbun. Moreover, the tribeswomen are highly skilled at palm weaving; this technique is used to create headdresses and other decorative items. As a side note, authentic handicrafts that are made and sold here bear the UNESCO Seal of Excellence and come with a certificate of authenticity.

# Pantau Iraga Art Space & Bangkita Ceramic Studio

Operating within a residential home is an art gallery known as Pantau Iraga Art Space & Bangkita Ceramic Studio. It was established by Professor Awang Damit, a popular local abstract artist who has also garnered international success. His personal collection of artwork is showcased in the exhibition hall section. Apart from two dimensional art, the central production here is beautiful handmade pottery and ceramics. These include home décor (vases and jars), tableware (cups, mugs, bowls and plates), wedding door gifts as well as wax decorations. Regarding the design, they are either maintained with single colour tones or painted with abstract patterns and muted colours.

## Rumah Seratus Ukiran



If you'd like to see a truly traditional Malay house, head over to Rumah Seratus Ukiran (translates to 100 Carvings House). As the name implies, there are over 100 different carvings etched in both the interior and exterior of this wooden building. This encompasses the walls, windows, staircases and roofs. However, this did not serve solely for decorative purposes. Back in the day, a house with many carvings also indicated a high status of the homeowner.

Originally standing in Teluk Intan (Perak), the then 70 year old house was demolished and rebuilt in Kampung Sijangkang with additional existing yet high quality timber such as chengal and resak wood. The construction took about four years to complete. This large kampung house is said to be capable of accommodating 100 people. Inside, antique equipment such as light switches, fans and lamps are still well maintained.

Over the years, it has been used as a filming location for several films and television series. This is not surprising as this gorgeous house, together with a small detached pagoda, stands out among the bountiful trees and full grass landscape – thus creating the perfect idyllic kampung house setting seen in olden times.

## Eco-Tourism

### *Morib Beach*

## Jugra Hill



## Places of Worship

### *Masjid Diraja Sultan Ala'eddin*



Located within a 1-minute walking distance of Istana Bandar, the beautiful Masjid Diraja Sultan Ala'eddin stands as one of the oldest royal mosques in Selangor. Also known as Masjid Bandar, it was constructed in the early 1900s under the orders of Sultan Ala'eddin Sulaiman Shah Ibni Al-Marhum Raja Muda Musa (fifth Sultan of Selangor). The pulpit in the mosque is often used by the sultan during his sermons.

In terms of the architectural design, it has a combination of traditional Moorish, Mughal and British colonial influences. Regarding the interior, there are walls with inscriptions from the Quran and intricate wood carvings. It can accommodate about 500 worshippers at any one time. Recently, the entire structure was painted white from the original yellow colour scheme. Moreover, this sacred building has been gazetted as a Historical Heritage Site frequented by tourists.

### *Fo Guang Shan Dong Zen Temple*

Erected in 1994, the Taiwan-originated Fo Guang Shan Dong Zen Temple is an enormous Buddhist religious, cultural and educational complex in Jenjarom town. It spans across a recently expanded 22-acre land. Within this religious tourist attraction lies an impressive giant Buddha statue. Find over 50 intricately carved statues of important Buddhist deities or spiritual figures all around the compound. Other attractions include the Waterdrop Teahouse, Zen Garden, Fo Guan Yuan Art Gallery (with a calligraphy hall and artefacts exhibition) as well as the Dong Zen Institute of Buddhist Studies. Additionally, the Lumbini Park houses pretty orchid displays, koi fish ponds and 3D models of popular Buddhist sites. Visit during Chinese New Year when the entire place is filled with red lanterns, LED lights and illuminated 3D structures.

## Traditional Dishes Of Kuala Langat

### **Nasi Ambeng**

*Nasi ambeng* consists of white rice, soy sauce chicken, fried noodles, vegetables, salted anchovies, *tempe* and fried peanuts mixed with grated coconut.

### **Pecal**

Typically sold in banana leaves, *pecal* is a sliced vegetable mixture of tapioca, spinach shoots, bean sprouts, cucumber, sweet turnip and long beans that are dipped in peanut gravy.

### **Tempe**

Made from fermented soybeans, *tempe* can be fried or steamed to be used in fried *sambal* and *lodeh*, or eaten plainly with soy sauce.

### **Sambal Goreng Jawa**

This sweet and spicy *sambal goreng Jawa* is made from *tempe*, prawns, vegetables, liver, anchovies, potatoes, soy sauce, dried tofu and more.

### **Ungkep**

Preferably made with village chickens as they are sweeter and firmer, *ungkep* is marinated in spices such as ginger, turmeric and coriander before being boiled in a covered pot.

### **Nasi Punten with Sambal Bilis**

Cooked with coconut cream (*santan*) and pandan leaves, *nasi punten* is finely pounded and stuffed into a *loyang* before sliced into squares. It is served with *sambal cili padi*, onions and anchovy *sambal*.

### **Sambal Taun**

Incredibly spicy courtesy of *cili padi* and bird's eye chilli, *sambal taun* is a long lasting gravy also made with shelffish, offal (cow skin, cow's stomach, cow lungs and chicken liver) and anchovies.

### **Ketewol**

*Ketewol* is an exclusive snack made from finely pounded tapioca flour. It is then steamed and mixed with grated coconut.





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# Mengenai Kuala Selangor

## *Sejarah*

Dari segi nama, Kuala Langat dipercayai telah disingkatkan dari kedudukannya di muara Sungai Langat. Malah, ia secara langsung diterjemahkan kepada "Gabungan Sungai Langat". Walau bagaimanapun, terdapat cerita penduduk lokal serupa yang telah membawa kepada bukan sahaja pembentukan nama tetapi juga pengukuhannya. Berhubung istilah 'air hangat' (diterjemahkan kepada air suam) dalam dialek Minangkabau, dikatakan bahawa saudagar-saudagar yang menggunakan sungai ini sebagai laluan perdagangan mereka mendapati air di muara sungai sentiasa panas. Di samping itu, ikan selangat yang tinggal di sini mungkin telah menguatkan lagi nama 'Langat'.

Juga dikenali sebagai 'Langat' oleh penduduk tempatan, lokasi awal bandar Kuala Langat adalah di Jugra (dahulunya dikenali sebagai Bandar Temasya). Sama seperti kawasan-kawasan lain di Selangor, ia seolah-olah diasaskan oleh masyarakat Bugis yang tiba dari Johor semasa perdagangan abad ke-18 dengan Melaka. Walaupun sejarah rantau ini berkemungkinan lebih tua, bukti menunjukkan Kuala Langat sudah wujud sekitar 2,000 hingga 2,500 tahun yang lalu. Ini berlaku sebelum perkembangan Kesultanan Melaka.

Pada zaman moden ini, Kuala Langat telah banyak berubah dari daerah kecil, yang terdiri daripada bandar-bandar kecil dan kampung-kampung. Sejak abad ke-21, daerah ini telah berkembang menjadi perbandaran yang sibuk dan dinamik. Selain daripada infrastruktur moden, terdapat hab perindustrian dan komersial yang berkembang pesat di tengah pusat bandar.



## Penduduk dan Kawasan

Terletak di kawasan barat daya Selangor, Kuala Langat merangkumi kawasan yang dianggarkan seluas 85,770 kilometer persegi. Daerah ini dipisahkan kepada lapan mukim atau pentadbiran yang terdiri daripada Jugra, Telok Panglima Garang, Bandar, Tanjung Dua Belas I, Tanjung Dua Belas II, Kelanang, Morib dan Batu; kawasan-kawasan ini telah disenaraikan dari Utara ke Selatan, mengikut urutan. Selain itu, Sungai Langat juga mengalir melalui beberapa bandar di Kuala Langat: Banting, Telok Datok, Jenjarom, Jugra dan Pulau Carey.

Mengenai daerah-daerah berjiran, ia terletak di antara Klang di Utara Barat dan Sepang di Timur Selatan. Di samping itu, ia mempunyai sambungan sempadan yang kecil dengan daerah Petaling Jaya. Selain itu, Selat Melaka terletak di Barat. Oleh itu, wilayah ini mempunyai garis pantai berpasir yang panjang. Kawasan lain yang menarik termasuk paya bakau, ladang kelapa sawit, sungai, hutan simpan, bukit dan pantai. Secara keseluruhannya, tidak menghairankan bahawa Kuala Langat telah berkembang sebagai sebuah daerah pertanian, dengan tanaman utama yang terdiri daripada kelapa sawit.

Dari segi populasi, daerah ini mempunyai kira-kira 357,420 jumlah penduduk. Menyelam ke etnik, Kuala Langat dipenduduki oleh masyarakat masyarakat Melayu, Cina, India, Jawa dan Orang Asli. Lebih-lebih lagi, terdapat dua kumpulan utama orang asli iaitu Mah Meri dan Temuan. Walau bagaimanapun, adalah adil untuk mengatakan bahawa orang Melayu mempunyai majoriti yang besar.



## Pelancongan Warisan Sejarah

### *Muzium Insitu Jugra*



Mempunyai sejarah sebagai penjara pertama di Selangor ialah Muzium Insitu Jugra. Menggunakan batu granit segi empat, ia dibina oleh pegawai polis British Kapten Harry Charles Syers pada 1878. Tingkat bawah telah berfungsi sebagai balai polis dan penjara manakala tingkat atas adalah bilik mahkamah; operasi terhenti apabila Penjara Pudu dibina pada tahun 1890. Struktur ini juga berfungsi sebagai pusat pentadbiran Kesultanan Selangor, sebelum dipindahkan ke Klang.

Kini, ia beroperasi sebagai sebuah muzium dengan tiga galeri yang mempamerkan maklumat, artifak dan dioramas sejarah (termasuk tapak warisan) dan pembangunan Kuala Langat serta kerja-kerja arkeologi dan pemuliharaan Rumah Pasung. Salah satu tarikan utamanya adalah kapal pengangkut anggota berperisai WWII yang ditunggang oleh Polis Diraja Malaysia semasa Tempoh Darurat (1948-1960).

### *Istana Bandar*

Dibina pada 1899, Istana Bandar yang megah telah ditauliahkan oleh Sultan Ala'eddin Sulaiman Shah Ibni Al-Marhum Raja Muda Musa (Sultan Selangor kelima) selepas kemangkatan nenda baginda, Sultan Abdul Samad ibni Almarhum Raja Abdullah, pada tahun sebelumnya. Juga dikenali sebagai Istana Ala'e'ddin, bangunan itu merupakan singgahsana baginda sehingga kemangkatannya pada 1938. Selepas itu, ia menjadi pusat pentadbiran kerajaan Selangor sebelum era Kemerdekaan; kemudiannya bertukar kepada pusat kraf dan agama.

Sebagai contoh, reka bentuk Islam yang berasal dari India dan rantau Timur Tengah adalah ciri utama manakala unsur-unsur Cina dapat dilihat dalam dinding ukiran sisik naga.

## Pelancongan Seni Dan Budaya

### Perkampungan Budaya Mah Meri

Penduduk di Pulau Carey, suku Mah Meri adalah sebahagian masyarakat Senoi yang tinggal di sepanjang pantai Selangor. Mereka merupakan salah satu daripada 18 komuniti pribumi yang masih berada di Semenanjung Malaysia. Secara keseluruhan, terdapat enam penempatan mereka di pulau ini: Kampung Sungai Judah, Kampung Sungai Bumbun, Kampung Sungai Rambai, Kampung Kepau Laut, Kampung Sungai Jugra dan Kampung Sungai Kurau. Kebanyakkan suku Mah Meri hidup terasing daripada populasi Melayu yang besar, sebahagiannya disebabkan oleh pemisahan pulau itu dari daratan (oleh sebab Sungai Langat). Walaupun begitu, mereka dianggap fasih berbahasa kebangsaan.

Dari segi kepercayaan, masyarakat orang asli di sini masih mengekalkan amalan animisme. Selain itu, mereka memberi kepercayaan dan penghormatan yang tinggi kepada roh nenek moyang mereka yang dipercayai membantu dalam kehidupan sehari-hari mereka - terutamanya datuk dan nenek serta orang-orang asli terhormat. Sebenarnya, salah satu perayaan terbesar adalah Hari Moyang; upacara sembahyang sebagai aktiviti penting. Ia biasanya berlaku sekitar bulan Mac atau April. Walau bagaimanapun, perayaan ini berbeza antara penempatan. Walaupun Kampung Sungai Bumbun (kampung pertanian) dirayakan pada bulan Februari di darat, Kampung Sungai Judah (kampung nelayan) menyambut pada bulan September di pantai kerana lokasi-lokasi ini adalah sumber pendapatan mereka. Selain itu, upacara perkahwinan adalah majlis besar di sini. Walaupun kampung budaya dibuka sepanjang tahun, disarankan untuk berkunjung semasa acara-acara besar ini. Di samping itu, lihat pameran seni unik yang melibatkan mitologi dan legenda tempatan.

Mah Meri terkenal sebagai pembuat topeng yang sangat mahir. Topeng muka penuh yang diukir dengan terperinci dipakai oleh mereka untuk melakukan tarian Jo'oh dan tarian topeng semasa perayaan. Ukiran patung juga merupakan kemahiran yang sempurna di sini, terutama di Kampung Sungai Bumbun. Lebih-lebih lagi, wanita daripada komuniti ini berpakar dalam pengganyaman sawit; teknik ini digunakan untuk membuat hiasan kepala dan barang hiasan lain. Lebih-lebih lagi, kraftangan asli yang dibuat dan dijual di sini telah dimeterai Kecemerlangan UNESCO dan disertakan dengan sijil kesahihan.

Rumah Seratus Ukiran merupakan rumah Melayu tradisional yang tulen. Terdapat lebih daripada 100 ukiran berbeza yang terukir di dalam dan luar bangunan ini, termasuk dinding, tingkap, tangga dan bumbung. Selain daripada tujuan hiasan, rumah dengan banyak ukiran menunjukkan status pemilik rumah yang tinggi.

Asalnya berdiri di Teluk Intan (Perak), rumah yang berusia 70 tahun itu dirobohkan dan dibina semula di Kampung Sijangkang dengan tambahan kayu berkualiti sedia ada seperti kayu cengal dan resak. Mengambil masa sekitar empat tahun untuk menyiapkan pembinaan, rumah besar ini dikatakan mampu memuatkan 100 orang. Peralatan elektrik antik seperti suis, kipas dan lampu masih terpelihara dengan baik.

Selama bertahun-tahun, rumah kayu ini telah digunakan sebagai lokasi penggambaran untuk filem dan siri televisyen. Kecantikannya, bersama dengan pagoda kecil yang didirikan berdekatan, menonjol di antara pokok-pokok dan landskap rumput penuh. Ini mewujudkan suasana rumah kampung yang indah seperti yang dilihat pada zaman dahulu.

### **Tempe**

Dibuat daripada kacang soya yang dipenapaikan, tempe boleh digoreng atau dikukus untuk digunakan dalam sambal goreng dan lodeh, atau dimakan dengan kicap.

### **Sambal Goreng Jawa**

Sambal goreng Jawa yang manis dan pedas ini dibuat daripada tempe, udang, sayur-sayuran, hati, ikan bilis, ketang, kicap, tahu kering dan banyak lagi.

### **Ungkep**

Sebaiknya dimasak dengan ayam kampung kerana lebih manis dan kental, ungkep diperap dengan rempah seperti halia, kunyit dan ketumbar sebelum direbus dalam periuk yang ditutup.

### **Nasi Punten dengan Sambal Bilis**

Dimasak dengan santan dan daun pandan, nasi punten akan ditumbuk halus dan dimasukkan ke dalam loyang sebelum dipotong menjadi segi empat. Ia disajikan dengan sambal cili padi, bawang dan sambal ikan bilis.

### **Sambal Taun**

Dengan cili padi dan cili mata burung yang pedas, sambal taun adalah kuah tahan lama yang juga dimasak dengan kerang, jeroan (kulit lembu, perut lembu, paru-paru lembu dan hati ayam) dan ikan bilis.

### **Ketewol**

Ketewol adalah makanan ringan eksklusif yang dibuat daripada tepung ubi kayu yang ditumbuk halus. Kemudian, ia dikukus dan dicampurkan dengan kelapa parut.
