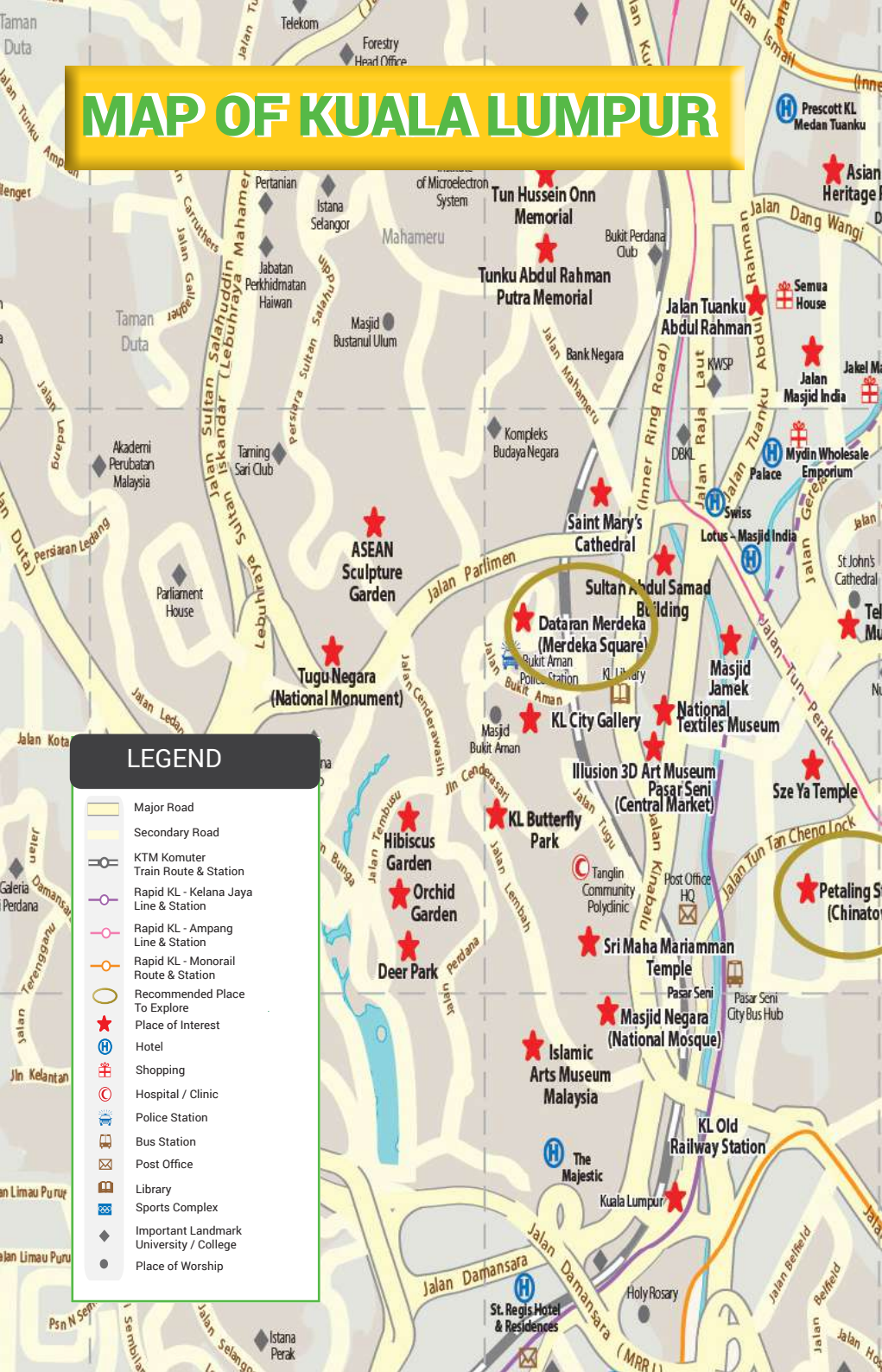

TRANSPORTATION

FROM KLIA & KLIA 2

Looking to travel from the airport to KL city? Not a problem! There are many ways. A trip on the KLIA Express train starts at 5 in the morning and finishes at midnight, with the journey taking approximately between 35 and 40 minutes to reach KL Sentral. The fare is RM55, however, passengers who travel in a group can get a 25% reduction.

You should try the Airport Coach bus or Aero bus when saving money is your primary goal because they're an affordable mode of transport compared to others which are more expensive such as taxis whose charges range between RM80 to RM200 depending on the distance covered from the city center. Moreover, they operate at different times on daily basis unlike other forms like shared vans. If you're looking forward to hiring an expensive taxi, expect to pay anything between RM200. If your concern is about price more than anything else, then look no further than Grab which have fixed options and starts at about RM65. Depending on what you want or can afford, there is always a way to suit your needs and budget!

FROM SUBANG SKYPARK TERMINAL

Take a look at the SKYPARK Link trains if you're heading to KL Sentral from Subang Airport! They are trips between 30 and 60 minutes, ensuring that you reach your destination in time. Currently, there is an ongoing offer which allows travellers to take only one journey from Subang Airport to Kuala Lumpur City at about RM3.50.

Note: The train service linking KTM's KL Sentral station and Skypark Terminal is temporarily unavailable

FROM SENAI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (JOHOR)

Options abound for your journey from Senai International Airport to Kuala Lumpur. For a scenic drive, renting a car takes about 3.5 hours. Buses are another budget-friendly alternative, with fares between RM 35 and RM 45. Alternatively, you can fly, with ticket prices ranging from RM 54 to over RM 1,000 and flight times of 55 minutes to 1 hour and 5 minutes. Each choice promises an enjoyable experience.

FROM SINGAPORE

Traveling from Singapore to Kuala Lumpur offers various options. For a direct route, one can opt for a flight from Changi or Seletar Airport, taking approximately 55 minutes to 1 hour and 20 minutes. Alternatively, driving across the Johor-Singapore Causeway or the Tuas Second Link is feasible. Buses are an economical choice with fares ranging between RM 5 – RM 26, while the KTM Shuttle Tebrau offers a swift 5-minute journey. Regardless of the mode of transport, the journey promises to be as enjoyable as the destination.

FROM THAILAND

Considering a journey from Thailand to Kuala Lumpur? There are several appealing options available. If you choose to fly, you can book a flight from Phuket or Bangkok, which typically takes about 1.5 to 2 hours. Alternatively, for a more scenic experience, you may drive or take a bus through the Malaysia-Thailand border, entering at either the Bukit Kayu Hitam or Padang Besar checkpoints, where customs processing may range from 30 minutes to a few hours. Buses provide an economical option for your trip. Regardless of your chosen mode of transport, the journey promises to be as captivating as the vibrant destination itself.



Train

For a fast and hassle-free trip from the airport to downtown Kuala Lumpur, the airport to downtown, take the KLIA Express train! It takes about 28 minutes to get to KL Sentral, and tickets cost RM55, which is quite reasonable. You can buy tickets either online or at KL Sentral, the main station. Also, enjoy fast onboard WiFi and a free porter service on certain platforms.

Moreover, Kuala Lumpur provides a range of rail services including MRT, LRT, KL Monorail, and KTM for smooth travel within the city centre. Easily navigate around and discover everything Kuala Lumpur has to offer!



Bus

Buses offer the most economical transportation option from airports to the city, boasting a fleet of 44 air-conditioned coaches known for their safety and comfort. Fares can start as low as RM15 per person, and while travel times may vary, the average duration to reach the city is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Additionally, RapidKL buses provide feeder services to MRT, LRT, and Monorail stations, making transportation within the Klang Valley and to KL City convenient. Various companies such as Go KL, Smart Selangor, and PJ City offer unique services, including free bus options. Explore Kuala Lumpur affordably and comfortably with these diverse bus services!

ALTERNATE WAY TO KL CITY CENTER

Taxi

Taxis, though still accessible, have become less favored because of their higher fares in comparison to e-hailing services. Residents often opt for e-hailing due to their predictable pricing and lower expenses. However, if you decide to take a taxi, it's recommended to negotiate and confirm meter usage beforehand to avoid being charged excessively. Generally, the starting fare is about RM3 for the initial kilometer, with an extra charge of RM0.20 for every 150 meters travelled.



E-Hailing Service

E-hailing services have gained immense popularity in Malaysia, embraced by both locals and tourists for their reliability and convenience via user-friendly mobile apps. These services provide a swift means of reaching destinations, particularly during periods of low traffic. The key attraction of e-hailing lies in its upfront pricing and the provision of accident insurance, making it a favored option for many. Numerous apps such as GrabCar, AirAsia Ride, InDrive, Kumpool, and others offer these convenient transportation choices.



Intercity Transportation: By Train, By Bus

By Train

KTM and ETS Komuter trains offer efficient and comfortable intercity travel across major routes in Malaysia. Here are some key routes:

1. **Batu Caves** – Pulau Sebang: This route connects the northern and southern parts of the Klang Valley, making it convenient for commuters.
2. **Tanjung Malim** – Pelabuhan Klang: Ideal for those traveling from the Port Klang of Selangor to the western coast.
3. **Padang Rengas** – Bukit Mertajam: This line serves the central and northern regions of Peninsular Malaysia.
4. **Butterworth** – Padang Besar: A prime route for travelers heading towards the Malaysia-Thailand border.

For longer distances, the ETS (Electric Train Service) provides comfortable and speedy services on these routes:

1. **Gemas - KL Sentral - Padang Besar**: A popular route connecting the southern and northern parts of Peninsular Malaysia.
2. **KL Sentral - Ipoh**: A convenient route for those traveling between Kuala Lumpur and Perak's administrative city.
3. **KL Sentral - Butterworth**: Connecting Kuala Lumpur with Penang, this route is perfect for business and leisure travelers.
4. **KL Sentral – Padang Besar**: This line extends all the way to the northern border, providing seamless travel to Thailand.

Additionally, the South & East Coast sectors are connected via three major routes:

1. **JB Sentral - Tampin**: Serving travelers in the southern region.
2. **JB Sentral - Tumpat**: A route linking the southern tip to the northeastern part of the peninsula.
3. **JB Sentral – Woodland Singapore**: Facilitates easy travel between Malaysia and Singapore.

By Bus

If you're traveling beyond Kuala Lumpur by bus, major intercity transit hubs offer excellent connectivity:

1. **TBS (Terminal Bersepadu Selatan)**: A central hub for buses heading north, south, and east.
2. **Terminal Putrajaya Sentral**: Convenient for those in the administrative capital.
3. **Pudu Sentral**: Located in the heart of Kuala Lumpur, serving various destinations.

INTRODUCTION OF KUALA LUMPUR

Kuala Lumpur, the bustling capital of Malaysia, epitomizes modern architecture and cultural diversity, offering a wealth of attractions. Spanning an area of approximately 243 square kilometers, the city is experiencing significant population growth and economic progress, ranking as the ninth most visited city in the world. As of 2024, Kuala Lumpur's metropolitan area population stands at 8,816,000, marking a 2.25% increase from 2023. Between 2010 and 2020, the city saw a steady population growth rate of 2.2%.

Located at the confluence of the Gombak and Klang Rivers, Kuala Lumpur lies 300 kilometers northwest of Singapore and about 40 kilometers east of the Strait of Malacca. Its name, meaning "muddy estuary" in Malay, reflects its geographical position at the meeting point of two rivers.

Kuala Lumpur is one of Malaysia's three Federal Territories, along with Putrajaya and Labuan, and has hosted major events like the 1998 Commonwealth Games and the 2017 SEA Games.

Looking ahead, Malaysia's GDP is expected to show strong growth, with the economy projected to recover in 2024. Growth is anticipated to increase from 3.7% in 2023 to 4.4% in 2024 and 2025.

HISTORY OF KUALA LUMPUR

The following is a chronological overview of Kuala Lumpur's historical progression along with its significant events until this current era.

1857

A group of 87 tin miners conducted exploration in the vicinity of Kuala Lumpur, discovering significant tin deposits in Ampang.

1862

The rapid growth of Kuala Lumpur attracted miners from various areas, leading to a rise in population as well as conflicts, disputes, and rivalries among gangs.

1869

Yap Ah Loy, who led the Chinese community in Kuala Lumpur, played a pivotal role in instituting law and order. Additionally, he initiated the establishment of the city's inaugural school and a refuge

1880

A British representative named Frank Sweetenham formulated an urban development plan to modernize Kuala Lumpur.

1887

Selangor designated Kuala Lumpur as its capital city.

1896

After the union of the four state sultans, Kuala Lumpur was designated as the capital of the Federated Malay States.

1910

Arthur Benison Hubback, a prolific British colonial architect, was responsible for both the design and construction of Kuala Lumpur's inaugural railway station.

1942

The city was under Japanese occupation during World War II.

1946

Kuala Lumpur was established as the capital of the Malayan Federation.

On August 31, Malaysia celebrated its Independence Day, marking the end of 151 years of British rule as they opted to leave the country.

1957

With an approximate population of 500,000, Kuala Lumpur encountered distinct administrative challenges.

1960

Kuala Lumpur was appointed as the capital city of Malaysia.

1963

Ethnic tensions escalated into a comprehensive civil conflict involving the Chinese and Malay communities.

1969

Kuala Lumpur attained the status of a city, becoming the first town in Malaysia to achieve this milestone after gaining

1972

Kuala Lumpur became a Federal Territory with its own government.

1974

Prime Minister Dr. Mahathir initiated the "Vision 2020" program during his tenure, bringing about modernization not only in Kuala Lumpur but across the entire

1981

Malaysia's federal administrative capital was relocated to Putrajaya.

1999

Kuala Lumpur Sentral, a key transportation hub and business district, officially opened on June 13, 2001, connecting trains, buses, and the KLIA Ekspres in the capital city.

2001

The 9.7 km Stormwater Management and Road Tunnel (SMART), the world's first dual-purpose underground motorway and water channel, was opened to reduce flooding in Kuala Lumpur's city center.

DID YOU KNOW?

Meaning of Kuala Lumpur

The term "Kuala Lumpur" stems from the Malay language, where "kuala" translates to "confluence" and "lumpur" means "mud." This name is associated with the specific location where the Gombak and Klang rivers converge. The founding of Kuala Lumpur dates back to 1857, when a small group of 87 Chinese tin miners swiftly established a settlement at this muddy junction of rivers. Following this, the town was officially named Kuala Lumpur.

Parliamentary Democracy System

Malaysia follows a political framework characterized by a constitutional monarchy and parliamentary democracy. Under this system, the King acts as the symbolic head of state, while the parliament holds significant authority in maintaining democratic values and overseeing governance.

Malaysian Government is in Putrajaya

Unlike the traditional setup where the government is centralized in the capital city, Malaysia's administrative and judicial hub is located in Putrajaya. Putrajaya serves as the primary center for various government offices in the country.

World's Tallest Twin Towers is in KL

The Petronas Twin Towers, once the world's tallest structure, were among Malaysia's tallest structures until they were surpassed by the recently completed Merdeka 118.

The Malaysian King lives in KL@Istana Negara

Situated on Jalan Tuanku Abdul Halim (formerly Jalan Duta) in Kuala Lumpur is the official residence of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, commonly referred to as the National Palace or Istana Negara.

Yang di-Pertuan Agong is an Elected Monarch

In Malaysia, while it's not an absolute monarchy, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong is selected through a distinctive rotational system for a five-year tenure by the Conference of Rulers. This method engages the Malay rulers, and the election procedures and rules are detailed in both the Constitution's Third Schedule and the Conference of Rulers' regulations.

Home To The Second Tallest Tower in the World

Did you know that the Merdeka 118 Tower has now become the world's second-tallest structure? It reaches a towering height of 678.9 meters, boasting 118 stories, and stands as the tallest building in Malaysia. The name "Merdeka 118" is derived from its 118 levels. Inspired by the outstretched hand gesture of Tunku Abdul Rahman, who famously exclaimed "Merdeka!" on Malaysia's Independence Day, the tower's design draws inspiration from this iconic gesture.

KL Was the First Country in Asia to Host the Commonwealth

Kuala Lumpur hosted the Commonwealth Games for the first time in 1998. Following this, the event returned to Asia in 2010 when Delhi hosted the Games.

Hosted the SEA Games in 2017

Kuala Lumpur was praised for its successful organization of the 2017 Sea Games. This achievement not only raised the country's reputation but also set new records in medal achievements.

KL is The Retail and Fashion Hub of Malaysia

With around 350 shopping malls spread throughout the nation, Malaysia has emerged as a bustling shopping hub, with Kuala Lumpur at its heart. 11 FEBRUARY **- THAIPUSAM**

Thaipusam is a major Tamil festival in Malaysia celebrating Lord Muruga's victory. The main event is a grand three-day parade at Batu Caves, where thousands of devotees gather to seek blessings. A silver chariot carries Lord Muruga, accompanied by drums and hymns. Many dedicated worshippers carry "kavadis" (elaborate structures attached to their bodies), as a sign of penance and gratitude. The festival highlights the deep devotion of Tamil communities in Malaysia.
