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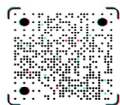
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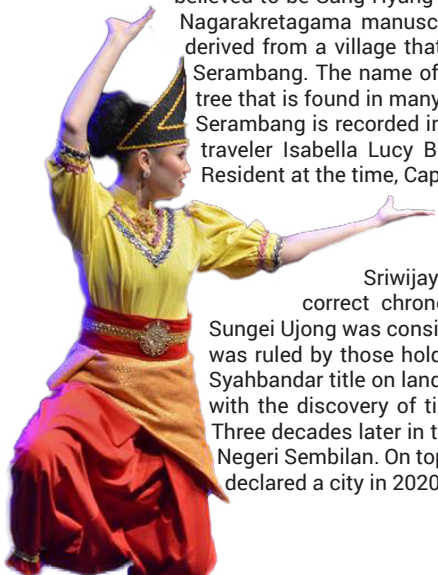
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About Seremban



History Of Sungei Ujong And Seremban

In terms of the name, Seremban was once known as Sungei Ujong, which translates to 'Back River'. This prior name seems to be contrived from an incident in which an enormous Merbau Tua tree in Rembau fell into a river that transformed into a population area, developed around the treetop discovery area. However, the original name was believed to be Sang Hyang Hujung (meaning God's Head), as stated in the ancient Nagarakretagama manuscript that was written in 1365. The Seremban name is derived from a village that existed since the late 18th century, namely Kampung Serambang. The name of this village is taken in conjunction with the name of a tree that is found in many swamps and rivers around this town. In fact, Kampung Serambang is recorded in the Map of Sungai Ujong drawn by the famous British traveler Isabella Lucy Bird in her book when she arrived to meet the British Resident at the time, Captain Murray.



Existing since the 14th century, Sungei Ujong has had a history of being under the jurisdiction of the Sriwijaya, Majapahit, Melaka and Johor government, in the correct chronological order. Before the British colonisation period, Sungei Ujong was considered the biggest and oldest administrative district that was ruled by those holding the Dato' Kelana Putera title on land and the Dato' Syahbandar title on land. During the 1870s, the area prospered as a mining area with the discovery of tin ore and soon became a flourishing business centre. Three decades later in the year 1900, Seremban officially became the capital of Negeri Sembilan. On top of that, the once small town of Seremban was officially declared a city in 2020.

Population And Area

Located in the western region of Negeri Sembilan, Seremban is not only known as a newly proclaimed city but it is also a district. It has an estimated landmass of 14,355.32 hectares. Within it, the district is separated into eight sub-districts or administrative divisions: Seremban, Rantau, Rasah, Pantai, Lenggeng, Ampangan, Setul and Labu. With reference to Seremban, it is located right in the middle of the district and surrounded by the other sub-districts.

In terms of neighbouring districts within Negeri Sembilan, it is surrounded by Jelebu, Kuala Pilah, Rembau and Port Dickson – these have been arranged in a clockwise order from North to South-West. Over in the North-Western region, Seremban shares a lengthy border with Kuala Lumpur. Additionally, the Linggi River runs through the district (including the Seremban area) from Pantai and ends at Kuala Linggi in Melaka. It is one of the last remaining rivers in Peninsular Malaysia to house a large number of saltwater crocodiles. In the case of attractive terrains, Seremban has a diverse range of them including palm oil plantations, rubber plantations, rivers, mountains, forests, wetlands and beaches.

Regarding the population, the Seremban district has an estimated total of 630,999 residents with approximately 349,168 of them living in the sub-district of Seremban, according to the findings made by the Department of Statistics Malaysia in 2020. The Malay community ranks as the overwhelming majority in terms of ethnicity, followed by Chinese, Indian and other ethnicities.



Negeri Sembilan is the only state that has preserved and exercised the 'Adat Perpatih', a customary law following the matrilineal system of administration and inheritance. Not only is the wife viewed as the head of the household, but the financial gains and material possessions are passed from the mother to the daughter.

Attire

The women are traditionally dressed in a baju kurung made with songket material and an elaborate velvet shoulder cover wrap. The most unique feature is the embroidered double-pointed headdress that has been folded in the shape of a bull's horn and decorated with gold ornaments or gilt brass. As for the men, they wear a jacket adorned with gold threaded embroidery, woven sampang (waist cloth) and a tanjak (headgear).

Music

Here are the mixture of woodwind, percussion and string instruments played during weddings and traditional dances: taklempong/caklempong, saluang, bansi, pupuik batang padi, serunai, rebab, aguang, gandang and biola. The bongai or traditional folk song is sung as a solo, duet or group.

Games

Sepak raga, or sepak takraw, is played by two opposing teams separated by a net court with the aim of keeping the ball aloft in the air. The game uses a ball made from woven strips of bamboo or rattan without hand contact. The original form of the game, sepak raga bulatan, was played in a circle

Tarian Piring:

As a fast-paced dance, tarian piring or 'plate dance' involves odd numbered dancers balancing these tableware on their palms. The movements are akin to that of farmers that are busy harvesting. As it is performed at wedding ceremonies, it ends with a bridal prayer after the trampling of the plates.

Tarian Lilin

Tarian lilin involves female dancers dancing while ensuring a lighted candle placed on a saucer does not fall from their palm. A ring is worn at the tip of the middle finger in order to tap the saucer in rhythm to the music.

Tarian Randai

Resembling more of a folk theater performance, tarian randai incorporates dance, drama, song, music, speech and martial arts. The leader or 'Tukang Goreh' leads the performance while fabled tales are reenacted.

Cuisine

The flavour profile of the local cuisine is typically hot and spicy with chili padi as a popular ingredient used. Coconut milk is also used in traditional Malay dishes such as rendang, sambal gesek and leman. Additionally, siew pao (steamed savoury bun) is a famous Chinese delicacy here.

Negeri Sembilan State Museum

Constructed in 1953, the Negeri Sembilan State Museum was operating under the Ampang Tinggi Palace, once located on Jalan Dato' Hamzah before it moved to the Craft & Cultural Park Complex in 1984. Resembling the traditional rumah gadang that's emblematic to the Minangkabau culture, the attractions here include the Negeri Sembilan Traditional House Model and Philately and Stamps Gallery.

Ampang Tinggi Palace

Once stood as a royal residence was the beautiful Istana Ampang Tinggi. Built as a replica of the iconic rumah gadang, this palace was commissioned by the 5th Yang Di-Pertuan Besar. Initially erected in Kuala Pilah, it was transported to Seremban and retained the exact structure. Remarkably, this wooden construction is connected without the use of nails.

The Royal Museum Seri Menanti

Located in the Old Palace is The Royal Museum Seri Menanti. The four-storey palace was reconstructed without nails by a pair of local craftsmen in 1908 after the first one was destroyed by British forces in 1875. In 1992, it became a royal museum showcasing the history, traditional costumes, weapons and other paraphernalia of Negeri Sembilan's royal lineage.

Rembau Museum (Replica of Raja Melewar Palace)

Heritage & Culture

Opened in 2004, Raja Melewar Palace is a replica of the original 300 year-old palace, bearing the same name, that once stood in the same site. It also operates as a museum called Rembau Museum. Learn about the royal family and the state culture from the artefacts displayed including antique agricultural tools, ceremonial items, musical instruments, weaponry and even the tepak sirih (betel set). There is also an exhibit showcasing traditional wedding attire and accessories, from the cucuk sanggul (hair pin) to dokoh (tiered pendant necklace), along with replicated rooms such as the singgahsana (ceremonial dais). Furthermore, the Raja Melewar Tomb is about 100 metres from the museum where the royal and his wife are laid to rest.

Lenggeng Recreational Park

Located within the Lenggeng Forest Reserve (a lowland dipterocarp forest) is the relatively small park referred to as the Lenggeng Recreational Park. As you explore your way inside, prepare to be stunned by the majestic waterfall that stands at an impressive 20 foot height and flows over several cascades. Stand or sit in the pool under one of the cascades to feel the powerful shower of waterfall flowing at full force. There is also a gushing stream nearby. As a side note, this park was opened to the public back in 1984. Therefore, visitors can expect to utilise several man-made facilities such as the children's playground, bridges and pathways as well as gazebos that will be a great spot for an outdoor picnic session.

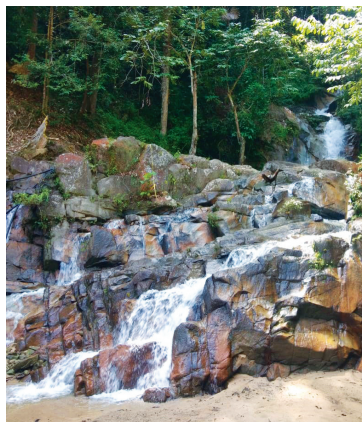

Jeram Toi

Jeram Toi, located within a forest reserve area, is perhaps the most popular waterfall in Negeri Sembilan. Cascading over four main levels, frolic in one of the pools or take a power shower under the second level waterfall. If you seek to visit the third and fourth levels, be careful when walking on the steep concrete steps that lead there. On another note, feel free to go on some of the water slides available for extra fun. Fortunately, visitors can expect a convenient journey to this natural wonder without worrying about enduring an arduous trek through the jungles. Instead, they only have to take a short walk from the car park to the entrance, before passing the stream and picnic gazebos to arrive at the primary bathing pool area. However, there is a hiking trail that has been paved for the more adventurous ones.

One of the go-to mountains to head to for an adventurous hike is Mount Angsi. Located in Ulu Bendul Recreational Park, this is a relatively minor mountain possessing a height of 2702 feet. It is the third highest peak in the state, after Gunung Datuk. View the panoramic view of the surrounding wooded hills at the top. Depending on the duration and intensity level, hikers can take either the Bukit Putus Trailhead or the Ulu-Bendul Angsi Trailhead. While the former is considered to be a moderately easy hike for fit beginners, the less popular latter is perceived to be quite challenging. However, be warned that the Ulu Bendul Trailhead ends with a steep descent. Overall, the journey takes about two to four hours to complete.

Ulu Bendul Recreational Park

Cradled within the Angsi Forest Reserve is the Ulu Bendul Recreational Park. Positioned at the southern edge of the Titiwangsa mountain area, the park was discovered in 1917 before it was commercialised in 1920. Estimated to be about 130 million years old, the park has winding footpaths that lead to a pond and flowing stream that is ideal for wading. Additionally, there are a large number of boulders along the Batang Terachi River that simulates an experience akin to a jacuzzi! Other outdoor activities offered are jungle trekking, mountain climbing, fishing and camping. There are also accommodations in the form of chalets and A-shaped huts located here, along with the required facilities and stalls selling affordable swimming items and snacks.

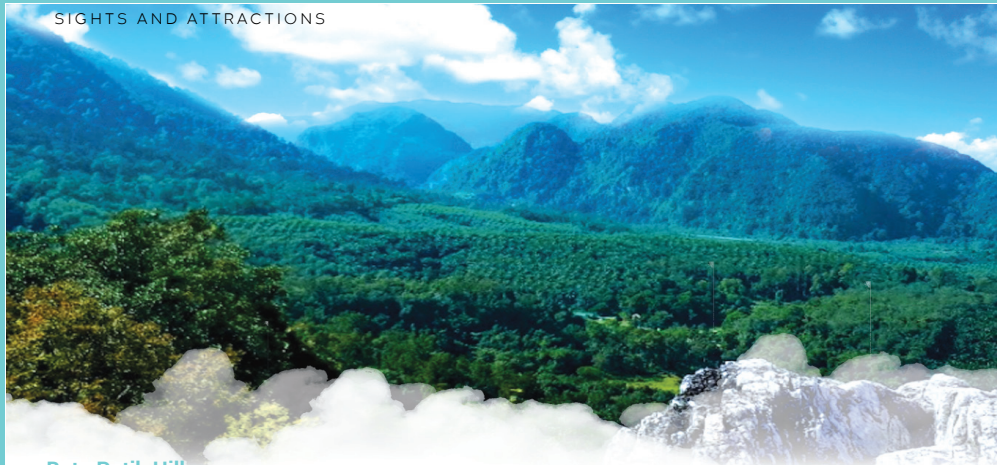

Batu Putih Hill

Situated slightly below the Tanjung Tuan lighthouse, Batu Putih Hill is a limestone peak perched on the hill of Cape Rachado. It is enveloped by one of Malaysia's last remaining coastal rainforests and sparkling blue bays. It offers a clear panoramic view of Port Dickson's coastline, including the Straits of Melaka. Reach the summit using either the jungle trail or beach trail; both of which start from inside the Tanjung Tuan Forest Reserve.

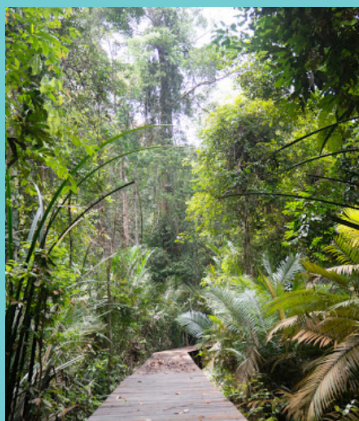
Melati Hill

Named after wildlife, each possesses a different level of intensity and distance. Furthermore, there are several stalls selling refreshments and thrifted or pre-loved hiking gear at the foothill.

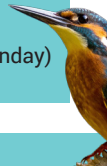
Sungai Menyala Forest Reserve

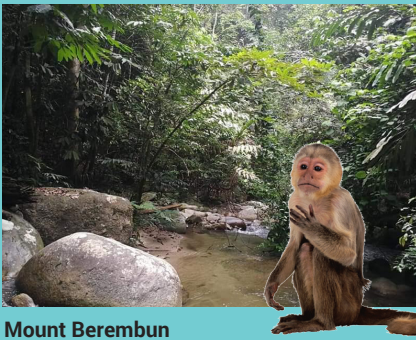
Covering approximately 1, 280 hectares, Sungai Menyala Forest Reserve is one of the largest lowland Dipterocarp forests in the area. There are also long stretches of virgin rainforest located here, not forgetting the notable 300 year old hollow tree believed to be the second oldest tree in the country. Aside from overhanging vegetation and wildlife animals roaming the forest, there are clear paths fit for exploring.

Blue Lagoon Beach

Situated about 15km from Port Dickson town is the popular Blue Lagoon Beach. Enclosed within a cloistered bay just before Cape Rachado, the bay's naturally deep recess and sandbanks protect this area from strong tides and currents. Therefore, the deep blue sea waters tend to be quite calm and shallow. It is also sheltered by verdant forests and vegetation from the encircling foothills. Moreover, visitors can often spot wildlife such as squirrels, monkeys and migratory birds, considering the Tanjung Tuan Forest Reserve is located nearby. Saujana Beach

Located along the 4th mile of Port Dickson, Saujana Beach is a beautiful spot with a wide coastline, fine sands and crystal clear waters. Apart from kite-flying and camping, the water-themed activities favoured here are jet-skiing and banana boating. In addition, there is a well-equipped park provided along the beachfront which includes playgrounds, gazebos and paved walkways that are shaded by flourishing greenery. Although the main entrance is situated opposite the Saturday Night Market, there are a few gravel paths that find their way to the beach between the remote hotels.

Cahaya Negeri Beach

Nestled in between the 5th and 6th mile of the Port Dickson beach road is the pretty Cahaya Negeri Beach. As one of the largest beaches in the region, the most popular activity here is fishing. It has even been equipped with several infrastructure such as food stalls, souvenir shops, parking lots and public bathrooms. The primary feature here is the artificial cape that has a recreational park lined with gazebos within it. On top of that, the cape leads to Pulau Burung, a small mangrove island off the coast, via a wooden bridge. Alternatively, visitors can stroll there during low tide.

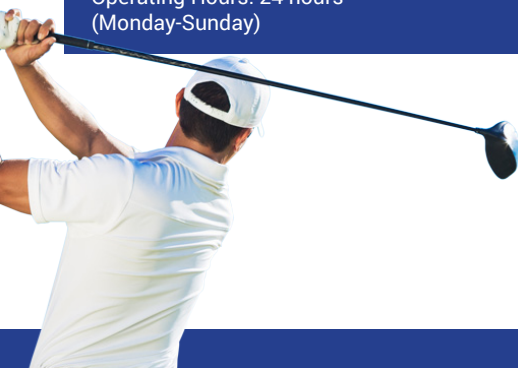

Also donated by Tan Sri Rashid Hussain, this beautiful white sacred building is the largest mosque in Seremban as it stretches across 4.5 hectares of land. Due to its pristine colour, it is also referred to as the 'White Mosque' and can accommodate 5, 000 people at any given time.

Sak Dato Temple

Tucked far away in the high hills of the peaceful Broga countryside lies the picturesque Sak Dato Temple. It was originally built around 140 years ago. The main deity worshipped in this garden temple is the mythological legend known as the mighty Monkey God or Sun Wukong. In order to see the huge statue resembling him, visitors will have to climb a long flight of stairs before crossing the suspension bridge connecting to the other side of the hill. Moreover, there are several impressively designed sculptures of Chinese folklore characters and giant local fruits along with fish ponds placed in the compound area.

Possessing an opulent architecture and grandiose fortress walls, the beautiful Wan Loong Temple is constructed in the form of a colourful giant dragon. This is unsurprising as 'Wan Loong' translates to 'Dragon of the Clouds'. The main deities worshipped here are Kuan Yin (Goddess of Mercy) and Sun Wukong (Monkey God). Visitors can also find statues of iconic figures from the literary classic, Journey to the West, here such as Xuan Zang and Zhu Bajie. Within the compound, marvel at the perfectly manicured shrubs, pretty archways and koi fish pond that decorate the garden as you take a stroll along the 'Great Wall' of the temple. Do stop by the man-made fountain to toss a coin for good luck.

Then Sze Koon Temple

Located at an estimated 127 metres above sea level at the top of Wu Gong Hill, get ready to take 264 steps to reach the 140 year old Then Tze Koon Temple. It has also been nicknamed 'Centipede Temple' due to the symbolic giant stone statue of the creature erected here. With a three-storey pagoda housing a laughing Buddha statue on the top floor, the other statues or deities erected in the vast compound include the God of Marriage or Yue Lao, Guan Yin and the Eight Immortals. There is also a beautiful pavilion devoted to Guan Di and a golden toad statue with a coin in its mouth near a koi pond that visitors can pray to for wealth and good fortune.

Although it was officially registered in 1990, this sacred building has actually been operating for nearly 40 years. As implied by the name, Lord Shiva is the main deity worshipped here. Arulmighu Maha Sapthakanniga Devi Temple

Overlooking Seremban town, the Arulmighu Maha Sapthakanniga Devi Temple is a modest yet charming Hindu temple located on the top of Bukit Kepayang, or Victoria Hills. This 100-year-old temple is believed to be the one and only Kanniamman temple in the country. It is also referred to as 'Kepayang Hill Kanni Kovil' or 'Virgins' Temple'. The latter would be more telling about the deities housed here as "Sapthakanniga" translates to "seven virgin goddesses". To be more specific, they consist of Biramme, Mageswary, Gaumaree, Vyshnavi, Varaagi, Magenthree and Samundy. As it is located on a hilltop, it is best to take a 15-minute hike or drive very carefully along the bumpy and steep road to reach there.

Developed by a businessman, this beautiful temple was primarily built for the use of the local Chettiar community. Although the intricately carved raja gopuram (multi-tiered tower) was originally left in a monotone shade of sandy brown, it has recently been painted with many vibrant colours that can be easily seen from afar. There is also a small landscaped area filled with greenery in the front entrance.

Church of the Visitation

Established way back in 1848, the stunning Church of the Visitation was founded by French missionaries for the local Catholic community. In fact, it is the oldest parish operating under the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Kuala Lumpur. The term of 'Visitation' is believed to be in reference to the missionary stops made by Father Letessier. However, the first resident priest, Father Perrichon, only began his service in 1888. From a modest attap chapel, the church currently stands with a much more modern structure influenced by the neo-gothic influence.

Regarding the church located in the heart of Seremban, the first missionary posted here was Reverend T.R. Jones.

Gurdwara Sahib Seremban

Constructed around 1900, Gurdwara Sahib Seremban was established by the small Sikh community that resided in Seremban town. It was originally erected as a single-storey building with an attap roof and plank walls near the railway station and the King George V school field. Five years later, it was moved to its present location. Over the years, the establishment has undergone many renovations with the most drastic one occurring in 1965, leading to the double-storey brick structure standing today. The first floor serves as the langgar hall while the second one functions as the Darbar Sahib.

Must-Try Snacks & Dishes Of Seremban



Masak Lemak Cili Padi

Literally translating to 'cook with coconut milk with bird's eye chillies', the Negeri Sembilan-originated masak lemak cili padi is essentially a base sauce that is then added with more filling ingredients such as meat, fish, eggs or even just vegetables. Sometimes, pineapple is even added for a touch of sweetness.



Apam Johol

Formerly known as 'apam daun rambai', apam johol is a sweet fluffy cake made from wheat or rice flour and brown sugar. It is then steamed and presented within thin sheets of rambai leaves. It is sometimes eaten with rendang or sambal tumis.



Hakka Mee

Simple yet hearty, Hakka mee is essentially flat yellow noodles that are tossed in a mixture of fish sauce, soy sauce and garlic sauce before it is sprinkled with a generous helping of fried minced pork and chopped scallions.



Mee Hoon Sotong

Using thin mee hoon or rice vermicelli, mee hoon sotong is a noodle dish drenched in a cuttlefish-flavoured broth and accompanied by slices of cuttlefish, braised pork and mustard greens as well as chili sauce for extra heat.



Beef Noodles

Often incorporating the springy lai fun noodles, the beef noodles sold here come with slices of juicy beef with either the tendon, tripe or lean parts as well as thick, mildly spicy gravy. Whether you choose the dry or soup version, it is topped with crunchy peanuts, pickled or salted vegetables and sesame seeds.



Siew Pao

Although the fluffy white siew pao is usually steamed, you can also find ones with a crispy baked exterior filled with savoury meat filling of either pork and chicken seasoned with oyster sauce, dark soya sauce and 5-spice powder. Additionally, there are sweet flavours available such as red bean and kaya.



Nasi Lemak Ikan Sembilang

While you may already be familiar with our nationally famous nasi lemak, the moderately spicy nasi lemak ikan sembilang includes an extra ingredient of fish, specifically the sambal fried ikan sembilang also known as ikan keli.



Sambal Gesek

As a staple condiment used in most traditional state dishes, sambal gesek involves several ingredients such as fried anchovies, onions, cili padi and garlic being ground together before the red paste is fried until an aromatic smell is formed.



Durian Mantin

As there are many durian orchards in Mantin, be sure to get a taste of the various types of durian sold there such as durian kampung, D24, D101, and the most popular, Musang King.



Sambal Tempoyak Daun Kayu

Made from shredded potato shoots (pucuk ubi) or cassava leaves, gulai tempoyak pucuk ubi is a side dish that is cooked with fermented durian (tempoyak), santan, lemongrass, garlic, shallots, petai, cili padi and turmeric.



Negeri Sembilan-Style Rendang

Using the Minangkabau method of cooking, the Negeri Sembilan-style rendang uses less spice but more ginger, lemongrass, galangal and santan. As opposed to the traditional rendang that adds chicken or beef, this version uses the more unconventional duck and cassava shoots.



Kari Kepala Kambing

Be prepared for the unconventional dish of kari kepala kambing, quite literally translating to "goat's head curry". This traditional delicacy is roasted and charred before it is accompanied by potatoes, sambal belacan and eggplant.



Yi Poh Mee

Incorporating thick noodles that have been greased in lard, Yi Poh mee is then tossed into a pool of thick, dark soy sauce. After that, it is topped with fried minced pork and barbeque pork slices or char siew before served with a small bowl of soup and sambal.



Wajik

Originated from Indonesia, wajik is a sticky, brown-coloured sweet treat made from steamed glutinous rice cooked in coconut milk, palm sugar and pandan leaves. Once cooled, it is typically cut into the shape of a rhombus or diamond.



Dodol

As another national classic, dodol is a palm sugar-based confectionery that is brown in colour and possesses a toffee-like consistency. It is made from coconut milk and rice flour before it is molded into small pyramids. Feel free to try more exotic flavours such as durian or pandan.



Kuih Sopang

Another delicious, sticky but white-coloured dessert is kuih sopang. Molded into a semi-circle shape, it is made from glutinous rice flour, bananas and gula melaka or brown sugar before it is filled with grated coconut. It is served in a gravy of thick coconut milk.



Salai Daging dan Itik

As the clue is in its name, 'salai daging dan itik' actually translates to 'smoked beef and duck'. Cooked over a charcoal flame, these succulent meats are often seasoned with mild spices to become the main staple dish.



Satay Tulang

While you may have tasted the typical satay made from chicken, beef and lamb, feel free to try out the locally popular satay tulang. Translating to 'bone satay', the meat comes with crushed chicken rib bones and is accompanied by the usual side dishes of nasi impit, cucumber, onions and peanut sauce.

Places To Eat

Although the temporal origins of Malay cuisine is undetermined, it is believed that it began around the 15th century during the golden years of the Melaka. To be more specific, its position as a vital global trade centre led to the incorporation of various spices, techniques and influences of other cultures. In Negeri Sembilan, the Minangkabau and Javanese influences are more prominent in this type of cuisine, which is often cooked slowly on low heat. In terms of the flavour profile, Malay dishes are typically spicy, tangy, herby and creamy. Must-haves to try are the rendang, masak lemak cili padi and apam johol.
